Because the Mustang was introduced in 1964 but advertised as an early 1965 model, it is often referred to as the 1964 1/2 Mustang. Initial production of the second round of Mustangs began on August 17, 1964. Production included 92,705 standard coupes that retailed for \$2,320 apiece and 28,883 standard convertibles that retailed for \$2,557 each.

In August 2018, Ford produced the 10-millionth Mustang; matching the first 1965 Mustang, the vehicle was a 2019 Wimbledon White convertible with a V8 engine. [6] The success of the Mustang launch would lead to multiple competitors from other American manufacturers, including the Chevrolet Camaro and Pontiac Firebird [7] (1967), AMC Javelin (1968), and Dodge Challenger [8] (1970).

The 64 1/2 convertibles had a 289cid engine, and the hardtops came with the less powerful 260 V-8. Thirty five convertibles were sold to dealerships and 195 hardtops were given out in dealer contests held in April of 1964. Clearly the new Ford Mustang was suddenly everywhere!

The engine lineup was changed, with a 200 cu in (3.3 L) "T-code" engine that produced 120 hp (89 kW; 122 PS). Production of the Fairlane's "F-code" 260 cu in (4.3 L) engine ceased when the 1964 model year ended.

The K code engine was available from 1964 up until 1967. It can be difficult to prove a true 1964 1/2 Mustang, but any early Mustang with a D, F or U engine code is definitely a 1964 1/2 Mustang. Mustangs with engine codes A or T are considered 1965's. Mustangs with the C or K code engine option could be either a 1964 1/2 or a 1965 Mustang.

All About the 1964 1/2 Mustang

The K-code 271-horsepower Hi-Po 289 was Ford's most powerful engine at the time of the Mustang's debut. Then Carroll Shelby stepped in, largely at Iacocca's request, to create the Shelby GT350 Mustang. The engines had a new and revolutionary design, with the cars were rated 306 hp at 4200 rpm. Unfortunately, only 522 of these were produced.

Engine choices: One of my owners manuals, says the choices of engine were, a 170 cubic inch inline 6 cylinder, requiring Regular gas, which at that time was at least 92 octane (sigh... ah for the good days!) Choice 2, was a 260 cubic inch 4V V8, producing 210 horsepower and required 92 octane or better regular gas.

The Mustang features the optional 289 V8, otherwise known as the D Code, which put out a respectable 210 b.h.p. One of the key giveaways that this is a 64.5 and not a later car is the presence of a generator instead of an alternator, visible here on the left side of the engine.

Technically, the "Hi-Po" 289 wasn't even available in the Mustang until June, 1964, a full two months after Mustang's launch, which then knocked the 210-hp D-code 289 down a peg as top engine option.
