Evidence suggests that many African, Hispanic, and Native American students' general non-interest in science and mathematics may in part be due to racial stereotypes - that is, those students may perceive these subject areas as white domains and thus totally unrelated to their world of experiences.

Although much of African Americans' other achievements in careers in mathematical science, in research, education, and applied fields have also been "hidden", the community of mathematicians has been growing. African Americans represented around 4-6% of the graduates majoring in mathematics and statistics in the US between 2000 and 2015.
