In pregnant individuals with risk factors for preeclampsia, prophylactic low-dose aspirin is recommended to reduce the risk of developing preeclampsia. Fifteen distinct risk factors are recognized, including elements of current and past medical and obstetrical history, family history, and examination findings.

Low-dose aspirin. If you meet certain risk factors — including a history of preeclampsia, a multiple pregnancy, chronic high blood pressure, kidney disease, diabetes or autoimmune disease — your doctor may recommend a daily low-dose aspirin (81 milligrams) beginning after 12 weeks of pregnancy.

Low-Dose Aspirin for the Prevention of Preeclampsia

Low-dose aspirin also is called baby aspirin or 81 mg (milligrams) aspirin. Talk to your provider to see if treatment with low-dose aspirin is right for you. You can buy low-dose aspirin over-the-counter, or your provider can give you a prescription for it. A prescription is an order for medicine from your provider. If your provider wants you to take low-dose aspirin to help prevent preeclampsia, take it exactly as she tells you to.

Low-dose aspirin is recommended for the prevention of preeclampsia among women at a high risk of developing the disease. Aspirin undergoes polymorphic metabolism, and it is well known that common genetic polymorphisms are related to aspirin intolerance. We hypothesized that the efficacy of aspirin prophylaxis may differ by ethnicity and race.

Low-Dose Aspirin for the Prevention of Preeclampsia Preeclampsia is a hypertensive disorder specific to pregnancy that remains a significant cause of maternal and neonatal morbidity and mortality. Identification of women who are most at risk for preeclampsia is imprecise.

The daily recommended aspirin dosage for at-risk pregnant women is 81mg, about a quarter of the amount you might take in a single dose used for pain relief. For preeclampsia prevention, ACOG recommends starting the dosage during the second trimester. Research shows this low dosage poses little risk to you or your baby.

Low-dose aspirin ranges from 60-150 mg daily but, in the United States, the usual dose is a 81-mg tablet. When low-dose aspirin is indicated for the prevention of preeclampsia during the prenatal period, most studies are referring to a 81-mg daily tab that is recommended by the American College of Obstetricians and Gynecologists (ACOG) [i].

Low-dose aspirin may be justified in women judged to be especially liable to early-onset pre-eclampsia severe enough to need very preterm delivery. In such women it seems appropriate to start low-dose aspirin prophylactically early in the second trimester.

Why Some Doctors Recommend Low Dose Aspirin for Pregnant Women

Autoimmune disease ACOG supports the recommendation to consider the use of low-dose aspirin (81 mg/day), initiated between 12 and 28 weeks of pregnancy, for the prevention of preeclampsia for women with these risk factors. Most experts go further to suggest that any benefits are realized when aspirin is started early by 16 weeks.
