Population size is regulated by factors that are dependent or independent of population density. Biological and non-biological factors can influence population size. Biological factors include interspecific interactions like predation, competition, parasitism, and mutualism, as well as disease.

1. Physical Factors: Physical factors that affect population distribution include altitude and latitude, relief, climate, soils, vegetation, water and location of mineral and energy resources. It is important to note that most of the physical factors influence population distribution only indirectly through climatic conditions.

What are the Factors Affecting Population Distribution?

Determining factors have included areas that offered defensive advantages, resources such as metals, salt, and fossil fuels, and locations on trading routes. In modern times proximity to commercial centers and transportation links, such as railways, canals, and airports, have become more important. The concepts of urbanization-the settlement and growth of cities-and suburbanization, the return to the countryside and the growth of commuter towns, are both examined.

Social, Economic Change Affect Decisions to Move Out of State

There are many human and physical factors that affect population distribution and population density across the world. Physical factors that affect population density include water supply, climate, relief (shape of the land), vegetation, soils and availability of natural resources and energy. Human factors that affect population density include social, political and economic factors.

Factors affecting population growth Birth rate - the number of births per 1000 people. A country with 30 births per 1000 people has a birth rate of $(30/1000) \times 100 = 3\%$. A young population and high fertility rate may cause birth rates to be high

Biotic Factors- Density Dependent Period 1: The population is able to grow exponentially because of abundant resources (food, water) and no predators. There are not many limiting factors so the reproductive rate exceeds the death rate. It is not close to its carrying capacity yet.

What factors affect population density and distribution ...

Economic variations (such as a depression or job growth), political changes (such as a new policy on family planning or a new tax break on dependents), conflicts (such as wars), public health trends and natural events (such as long-term droughts or an earthquake) can impact birth and/or death rates.
