## **Questioning Strategies - CITL**

In the real world, good questions tend to be thought of as such because of their effect (e.g., if the person answering can't do so, or it frames old information/circumstance in a new light, we might say 'That's a good question.) In the classroom, students are typically burdened with proving what they know, so questions that imply that they 'get it' and don't (identifying knowledge gaps and yielding 'useful data') are considered 'good.'

## **EFFECTIVE QUESTIONING TECHNIQUES**

Aim for direct, specific questions. During class discussions, rather than beginning with a single question that is multilayered and complex, use a sequence of questions to build depth and complexity. Essay questions on exams or paper assignments, on the other hand, often provide an appropriate opportunity to ask multi-layered questions.

In general, recall and lower-level questions will take most students 1-3 seconds to answer. Questions that require calculation, such as  $11 \times 3$ , usually take 4-6 seconds to generate a response. Higher-order questions that require more thought than the simple recall questions, could take anywhere from 6 to 10 seconds to formulate a reply.
